These can be published through the CHILD-BRIGHT newsletters and blog.

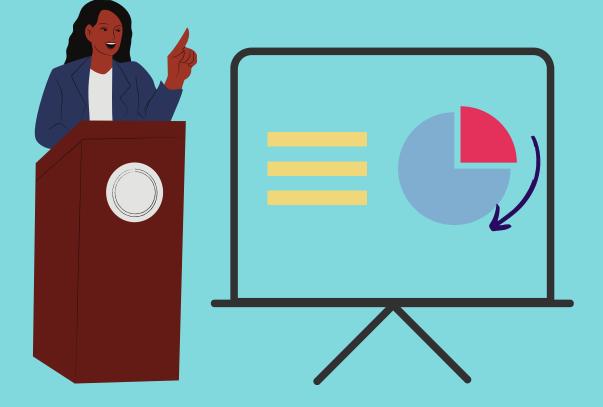


CREATE VISUALS
